November 3, concurrently with the conferment of decorations and medals to

Japanese nationals. On 3rd November 2015, the Government of Japan announced

the conferment of decorations on 89 foreigners, of which 13 will receive The Order

of the Rising Sun, Gold and Silver Star and 18 will receive The Order of the Rising

Sun, Gold Rays with Neck Ribbon.

4. The Orders of the Rising Sun are bestowed upon individuals of merit, in recognition

of their outstanding contribution to the nation or public. The Orders of the Rising Sun

are also conferred upon foreign nationals who have made notable contribution to

promotion of exchanges between Japan and other countries in fields such as

research and education, medicine and social welfare, economy and industry, and

culture and sports.
